

**Executive Outcomes: Iluka, Midwest, AIM, Tamaya, Frontier, Coeur, Adamus, Eleckra, Avanco, Stirling**

**MINERAL sands producer Iluka Resources has lost the services of chief financial officer David McMahon and, while the company seeks a replacement, current general manager of finance Simon Green will take on the role in the interim.**

Takeover target **Midwest Corporation** has farewelled company secretary Neil Roberts, who resigned to take up another position.



African focused **AIM Resources** has reshuffled its board to steer the Perkoa zinc project in Burkina Faso into production.

Vic Bradley has relinquished his chairman role to current managing director Marc Flory and will remain on the board as an independent director.

Bill Cash will step up as managing director.

"**AIM Resources** is a maturing company and as the company's cycle evolves, we need to add strength to our board with the skill sets, which will allow us to extract maximum value from our projects," Flory said.

"In this respect, we are fortunate to have the expertise of Bill Cash who has been involved in the development phase of a number of projects, including the McArthur River zinc project in the Northern Territory, and the Lisheen zinc and lead project in Tipperary, Ireland," he added.

Copper and gold play **Tamaya Resources** has appointed two exploration directors to strengthen its operations in Chile and Portugal. Eric Roth has joined the company as exploration manager of South America and Peter Schoenherr has joined as Portugal's exploration manager.
